Format of Play	Stableford
Tee Boxes	Men: WHITE Tee Women: RED Tee
Rules & Regulations	This Event shall be played in accordance with the R & A & USGA Rules of Golf and the local Rules of the Venue Club.
Handicap	CSC GS Members shall play off their CSC Handicap as determined by the GS Sub-Committee. CSC Members and Guests shall play off their official Handicap issued by the SGA/MGA/USGA/etc.
Countback	In the event of a tie, the CSC Countback Rules shall apply. (refer to CSC Bye-Laws)
Prizes	The following prizes shall be awarded for this Event (CSC Members Only): 1. Div 'A' (Handicap 19 and below) - Top 3 placings 2. Div 'B' (Handicap 20 and above) - Top 3 placings 3. Hole-In-One OR Eagle Achiever - Special custom-made Award NTP - Winner for each Par 3 Hole Special Hole-in-One Award donated by Mr Edwin Lee, President of CSC (At all Par 3 holes, applicable to the first H.I.O achiever only) "A Trip for the 4 golfers (GS members only) in the same flight" to Sydney, Australia (T&C apply)
Other Matters	1. All competitors must report to the tee-box/starter at least 15 mins before the allocated tee-off time. 2. A competitor who misses his tee-off time may be disqualified. 3. No substitution or mutual exchange of Flights is permitted without the consent of the Tournament Director. Offenders may be disqualified. 4. Every competitor must exchange his score card with another competitor on the same flight. 5. Every competitor must sign his score card and ensure that his Marker also signs his score card. Unsigned score cards may lead to disqualification. 6. Signed score cards must then be submitted to the Organisers or designated collection point immediately after the game. 7. A ball lying within Putter Length (ball not touching the rubber handle with putter head placed within the cup) is considered a 'gimme'. Pick up the ball and add one stroke to your score. 8. All complaints, protests and disputes shall be referred to the Tournament Director whose decision shall be final. 9. If a game is disrupted/uncompleted due to adverse weather conditions or whatsoever, Members of the GS Sub-Committee present shall make the necessary decision/s in consultation with the Tournament Director and such decision/s shall be final.
