Seeding	The tournament seeding will be based on: 1. SBA National Ranking as of 30 July 2026 - The tournament Referee will decide the number of seedings for each category. - The Referee will draw lots to determine the ranking if there are 2 or more players with the same ranking points

Tournament Regulations (Conditions of Play)	1. This tournament will be run in accordance with, but not limited to, the Badminton World Federation (BWF) Statutes and General Competition Regulations (GCR). In the event of any dispute, the decision of the Tournament Referee shall be final. 2. Alternate Service Laws will be applied for this tournament (BWF Statutes, Section 9.1.6) 3. All the events will be played on a Single Knockout system. 4. The scoring system will be based on the best of 3 games of 21 points for all categories. 5. There shall be no replacement/substitution of players once the entries are submitted. However, the Organising Committee, at its discretion, reserves the right to accept such changes if necessary and with valid reasons, so long as no match has been played by the player/s. 6. All players must report to the desk officials at least 30 minutes before the scheduled time of their matches 7. A grace period of maximum 5 minutes will be given for all matches. Failing which the player will concede a walkover for the particular match. 8. All players must always bring along their photo identification documents for verification purposes, failing which they might NOT be allowed to play. 9. Outcome for withdrawal, walkover and retire of matches. No appeal shall be entertained.

10. In the event of both players failing to turn up, the match will be scratched.
11. All players are required to wear non-marking court shoes during the competition
12. Players are required to stay on the court **AFTER** their match has ended, to act as line judges for the following match. **Players who fail to do so may be disqualified from the competition.** Players may also be called randomly to act as line judges for the 1st round of matches for the session. Line judges will be provided from the Semi-Final onwards.
13. The tournament Referee shall have the final decision on all technical and tournament matters. The Organising Committee shall have the final decision on all administrative matters.
14. All doubles pairs are required to wear attire of at least the same colour, if not the same design and colour, from the quarter-final onwards.
15. Only ONE coach is allowed per side, regardless of singles or doubles.
16. Any appeal regarding a point of dispute shall be made before the next service is delivered. The decision of the umpires and officials shall be deemed final.
17. The order of play may change at the discretion of the Referee/ Organiser.
18. Matches may be called up to 10 minutes ahead of schedule
19. Coaches and parents/guardians are required to wear appropriate attire during matches, including long pants, covered shoes, and avoid sleeveless tops and Crocs shoes when seated in the coach seats. The same clothing requirement is also applied to the first aider performing his/her duty on-court.
20. **ONLY** certified FULL NROC coaches are permitted to be seated behind the courts for coaching purposes. Coaches must present their NROC e-card as proof of certification. Players holding an SBA member ID are required to be coached exclusively by NROC-certified coaches.
21. Coaches without a valid NROC certification will not be allowed to coach from the bench but may observe matches as spectators. The updated SBA Coaching Regulation for Sanctioned Tournament, effective from 24 January 2025, is available on the [SBA Facebook page. \(Annex A\)](#)
22. Players without a valid NROC certification will not be allowed to coach from the bench but may observe matches as spectators.
23. Players who coach without a valid NROC certification may be penalised.
24. This regulation may be waived for foreign participants and their coaches who may not be NROC certified. Foreign coaches must provide photo ID documentation that confirms their coaching credentials in their home country, with details that match their passport particulars. The Tournament Organiser and Referee Team reserve the right to further review

	these documents and may reject any that cannot be verified or request additional evidence for validation. 25. The above regulation stated in Points 20 to 23 does not apply to local participants competing in U9, U11 and U13 categories 26. The tournament medical team will not administer spray during matches. However, players or their coaches may apply the spray themselves during match intervals.

Prize Presentation Ceremonies	1. All prize ceremonies will be on Sunday, 13 September 2026, immediately after the last final. 2. In accordance with Player Commitment Regulations (BWF Statute 5.3.6), all players participating in the finals of a tournament must attend the final ceremonies directly after the match or must follow the instructions given by the organisers regarding ceremony protocol. 3. No equipment, including rackets and flags, is allowed to be brought onto the podium. No slippers and/or singlets are allowed. 4. Prize winners are to proceed to the Registration Counter after the ceremony with their photo IDs to collect their prize money.
Video Recording and Photography	1. Photography is only permitted if there is no interference/disturbance to the play. No flashes will be allowed, 2. Video recording within the competition venue is only permitted if the device is not obstructing any walkway/pavement, etc. The tournament organiser reserves the right to remove any equipment if they deem that the devices are causing any obstruction to the players, officials, and spectators. 3. All participants shall agree to give SBA and the tournament organiser the rights, including permission to film players and coaches during all matches and activities around the tournament, for any commercial, news or other purposes, together with the right to transfer such rights, including without compensation 4. No media recordings (photograph, video or audio) shall be accepted as supporting evidence to appeal decisions made by referee / umpire / tournament organiser. All decisions made during the match shall be final.
Medical Services	1. A medical officer / first aider will be available during the tournament.
